Accepted	<p>HMP Nottingham have named case co-ordinators allocated to those on an open ACCT and they will conduct all case reviews to ensure consistency throughout the process. The prison aims to ensure the review team remains consistent but there may be occasions when this is not possible due to the availability of staff. ACCT reviews are now conducted on weekdays and each wing now has a dedicated mental health nurse who will attend each case review.</p>	Head of Safety	Implemented
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A case review is held shortly before an identified trigger date (such as the anniversary of a death or anniversary of the offence). 	Accepted	<p>HMP Nottingham have introduced a trigger database that can be access by all establishment staff and this information is also included within the daily operational report. Anyone with an identified trigger date will receive a welfare check by a member of the Safety Team. Significant triggers will initiate a review prior to the trigger date.</p>	Head of Safety	Implemented
