1	<p>The Head of Healthcare should ensure that where a patient has a confirmed history of a serious mental illness and there is evidence of risk to others, the mental health team should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> document whether they have considered detention under the appropriate section of the Mental Health Act; if this is not felt to be appropriate, record a rationale for this decision; and record all considerations and decisions in the multi-disciplinary meeting notes 	Not accepted	<p>The mental health team take responsibility for documenting the rationale for assessing an individual whether that includes an admission to healthcare for mental health observations or not. In the event that it is documented that an individual is acutely mentally unwell we will document a plan for treatment and/or consideration of detention where appropriate.</p> <p>This plan would encompass a rationale for this clinical reasoning and will be documented in MDT forums and within care plan where appropriate. It would only be documented if consideration was taking place for detention and not in all cases that are under the mental health team, where there is evidence of a risk to others.
