1	The Governor should review whether staff are effectively identifying objective risk factors and triggers when assessing prisoners' risk of suicide and self-harm rather than relying solely on their presentation.	Accepted	<p>HMP Warren Hill will hold a safety awareness week that will be supported by the Group Safety Lead to raise awareness of the need to identify risks and triggers, rather than relying solely on the prisoner's presentation, when assessing risk of suicide and self-harm. Protective factors will also be highlighted. This will be achieved via displays in the gate area, drop-in sessions, floor walking and notices to staff.</p> <p>The Head of Safer Custody and Safer Custody Custodial Manager have delivered risk and trigger awareness to all case managers.</p> <p>Additionally, HMP Warren Hill will introduce a defensible decision form for case coordinators to use whenever the ACCT multidisciplinary case review team are considering ACCT closure. This will prompt the case review team to consider risks and triggers rather than relying solely on a prisoner's presentation.
