There will be a review and relaunch of monthly integrity tests which challenge staff on the action to take, including what they would transmit over the radio, in a code red/code blue scenario.  Duty Governors and Orderly Officers will review non-fatal incidents to check that appropriate codes were used, and take action where necessary to ensure staff understand their responsibilities.  Bitesize training on medical emergency codes will be delivered to all operational staff at morning briefings.
