1	The Governor should ensure that ACCT care plan actions are quality assured regularly to satisfy himself that all actions have been fully completed.	Accepted	All open ACCT documents are subject to quality assurance checks using the mandatory national ACCT quality assurance system. These checks are performed by both supervising officers and custodial managers who will monitor the quality of case management, identify areas of concerns and provide support where necessary. Good practice is also highlighted to promote continuous improvement. Additionally, ACCT management procedures are subject to review by senior leaders during the daily morning meeting. This includes reviewing live caseload figures, new openings, closures, emerging risks, and any key concerns. Areas that require support or intervention are identified and acted upon swiftly. ACCT case management also features within the weekly SIM meeting, where a nominated wing is chosen to be the focal point of multi-disciplinary discussions.	Head of Safety, HMPPS	Completed

			Any open ACCT documents for that wing are reviewed, including the progression of any support actions in the care plan.		
2	The Head of Safety should ensure members of the team keep SIM meeting minutes and that, as far as is reasonably possible, there is adequate cover when staff are on leave to deal with safeguarding referrals.	Accepted	All members of the safety team have been reminded of the importance to consistently record SIM meeting meetings and that these are stored appropriately. There is now a daily safety task list rota in place, and this includes covering the minutes of the SIM. Additionally, the weekly SIM meeting agenda has been reviewed, and an item has been added that covers safeguarding referrals and prisoners of concern. During this item, safeguarding referrals are discussed, and available staff members are identified who can complete the action. Actions are then noted and followed up at the next SIM.
