In addition, the Governor has provided a dedicated space for GPs to access a PC for reception screening and to allow access to digital Prisoner Escort Records. A minimum of 3 healthcare staff will be booked onto each monthly session to ensure the entire team receives training. GPs will be prioritised to attend training sessions.
