The Head of Healthcare is satisfied that there is a system in place to ensure every prisoner who is active with the Drug and Alcohol Recovery Team (DART) is offered training prior to release with regards to the use of naloxone and is also offered a naxolene kit on release and that staff are aware of this process. DART staff are responsible for collating release dates of all their patients and ensuring naloxone kits are available for their discharge process. On the day of discharge all prisoners identified by DART are offered a naloxone kit within reception prior to release. The discharging nurse must record on SystmOne whether the prisoner has accepted or not accepted the treatment.	Head of Healthcare Spectrum Health	Completed
