ACCT quality assurance checks now monitor compliance with this instruction and ensure that discussions about release dates are also being noted appropriately.  Guidance has been shared with ACCT Case Coordinators setting out that when a prisoner is approaching release they must liaise with the Prison Offender Manager (POM) and relevant partnership agencies, and where possible they should attend case reviews and contribute to ensure that external agencies are aware of potential risk factors and can arrange for appropriate support and through the gate services to be offered.
