1	The Governor should ensure that a robust process is in place to review Early Release on Compassionate Grounds (ERCG) refusals and resubmit applications where an individual's health has deteriorated.	Accepted	ERCG status is reviewed weekly via both the IRMM (Intensive Intervention and Risk Management) and the SHARE (Support, Help, Assess, Refer and Engage) meetings. The SHARE meeting is a multi-disciplinary approach to collation, reviewing and assessing a change in circumstance for any individual with a terminal illness. This meeting captures any change of circumstance as provided by the Healthcare providers, to identify when the application will be resubmitted for a change of circumstance. 2	The Governor should ensure that staff understand the requirements for Release on Temporary Licence for medical purposes and a robust process is implemented to ensure applications are made when appropriate.	Accepted	The Head of Offender Management has shared the relevant policy within the function via staff briefing, they will have responsibility for commencing the applications with a subsequent panel convened by the Governor or in her absence the Deputy Governor.
