Should more time be required for investigation they can be switched to Good Order or Discipline (GOOD) but the patient will have another algorithm completed. • GOOD - Patient can be held in Segregation up to 14 days under this rule. 			<p>days a new algorithm (fitting) is completed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cellular Confinement (CC): Is for any allotted period of time as punishment following adjudication, the length of this varies relative to the punishment/offense. <p>Other reviews carried out in the segregation unit by healthcare:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All patients are reviewed daily by healthcare and they can lift the fit status at any time.• Segregation Rounds are completed by the GP Monday, Wednesday and Friday.• Hotel 1 completes Segregation Rounds on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday.• Mental Health team also complete their own Segregation Rounds on Mondays and Fridays.

2	<p>The Governor should ensure that there are effective quality assurance arrangements in place so that she can be satisfied that both the Prison Safety Policy Framework (formerly PSI 64/2011) on ACCT monitoring and Prison Service Order (PSO) 1700 on segregation are being followed.</p>	Accepted	<p>HMP Wormwood Scrubs have reviewed and published their local safety strategy, in accordance with the Prison Safety Policy Framework. The strategy includes mandatory actions concerning ACCT monitoring and quality assurance. Where issues are identified, they are escalated to the relevant residential managers and urgent issues are rectified immediately.</p> <p>A safeguarding nurse will be recruited who will co-ordinate the ACCT case reviews to ensure relevant healthcare attendance if necessary. Additionally, all scheduled ACCT reviews are shared with the healthcare team daily.</p> <p>The segregation custodial manager will complete regular checks on segregation paperwork to ensure compliance with directions within both Prison Service Order 1700 and local processes.
