2	The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that all staff undertaking risk assessments for prisoners taken to hospital or on a bed watch understand the legal position on the use of restraints and that, in all cases: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> managers responsible for authorising restraints consider the healthcare input into the escort risk assessment and base their decision on the actual risk the prisoner poses at the time; and 	Accepted	The Head of Safety and the Head of Healthcare will provide an escort risk assessment training workshop for all healthcare and operational managers undertaking risk assessments for prisoners who are taken to hospital or on bed watch. The training will provide clear guidance on what staff must consider when making decisions about the use of restraints in line with the Graham Judgement, including consideration of a prisoner's risk of escape, medical condition and any mobility issues.
