1	The Head of Healthcare at HMP Wayland should ensure there is a robust system to monitor and respond to referral requests promptly, to support timely referrals and continuation of care after release.	Accepted	<p>All patients under the care of the mental health in-reach team are referred to community mental health services. However, there are barriers that have been raised to Practice Plus Group national teams that there is a high volume of referrals that are rejected due to risk of homelessness and no confirmed address. We have also experienced community mental health team referrals not being accepted due to dispute between areas of which service is responsible for patient care, this has been experienced especially within London boroughs.</p> <p>We liaise with our offender management colleagues within the prison, and link in with community probation services to try and ascertain a confirmed release address and raise concerns regarding the need for stable</p>	Head of Healthcare, Practice Plus Group. 		<p>housing and continuity of care with mental health services, but this is not always achieved by probation colleagues prior to a patient's release.</p> <p>There are many examples where transfer of care is achieved for patient's being released from prison, and this transfer of care is smooth, especially if returning to their same area/location where they are known to mental health services.</p> <p>Whilst patients are in prison and remain under a community mental health team, we organise teams calls with their community care-coordinator for patient involvement and to provide updates regarding sentence progression and mental health presentation. This also allows to prepare for release and to provide transfer of care, medication information and any risk concerns.</p>		
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
