1	The Governor should ensure that when prisoners meet the criteria for constant supervision, a documented multi-disciplinary conversation takes place to determine the appropriate level of ACCT observations if they are not subject to constant supervision.	Accepted	<p>ACCT case managers have been reminded of the criteria that requires constant supervision to be implemented. They have also been instructed to escalate such cases to the Duty Governor and to document the decision on both the National Offender Management Information System (NOMIS) and within the ACCT case review. Additionally, the Safety team check all new arrivals for any Suicide and Self-Harm (SASH) alerts on NOMIS and notify the relevant members of staff to ensure actions are taken to mitigate the risk.</p> <p>Following the national introduction of ACCT version 6, all documents are now subject to a mandated quality assurance process. As part of this, prisoners who are deemed to be either high or complex level of risk are checked weekly by a member of the Senior Management Team.</p>	Head of Safety HMPPS	Complete
