Accepted	<p>NTS 083 – 2025 has been shared via global email to all prison staff within HMP Isle of Wight. Dip tests will be conducted in reception and during bed watch checks to ensure that staff undertaking escorts and bedwatches duties have read and understand the contents of the notice. All Operational Managers who complete risk assessments will be required to confirm via email to the Head of Operations that they have read and understood the requirements of NTS 083-2025.</p> <p>The Head of Healthcare will instruct healthcare staff to accurately reflect any mobility issues or other medical condition that they feel may impact on the use of or type of restraint.
