Accepted	<p>The Challenge, Support and Intervention Plan (CSIP) single case manager approach is now in place. All case managers have received additional training around CSIPs, and training has been delivered to officers on training days. Further training events are planned for both operational and non-operational staff, including healthcare staff.</p> <p>CSIP records have also moved across from the NOMIS system to the DPS system making record keeping more effective.</p> <p>CSIP quality assurance (QA) checks are now completed on all CSIPs and learning is fed back to individual case managers. The CSIP QA is completed by the Safety Custodial Manager who is also involved in delivering CSIP training.
