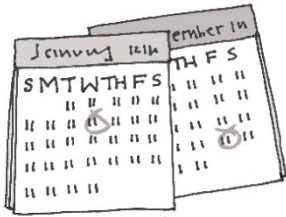




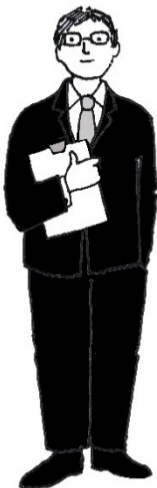
Inspection of HMYOI Feltham A



Inspectors visited this YOI in March 2024.



We wanted to find out if things were better, the same or worse for young people since we last visited in 2022.



We did this by:

- looking around the YOI
- asking young people and staff to fill in a questionnaire
- speaking to young people
- speaking to staff and helpers
- reading documents.

What did we find?



There was too much violence and too many young people were harming themselves.
We gave the prison 1 out of 4 for this.



Young people got some good support from staff.
We gave the prison 3 out of 4 for this.



Young people did not get enough time out of their cells. Education and training were not good enough.
We gave the prison 1 out of 4 for this.



Young people got some good support to help them get ready to leave Feltham YOI. There was not enough help for young people to see their families.
We gave the prison 3 out of 4 for this.

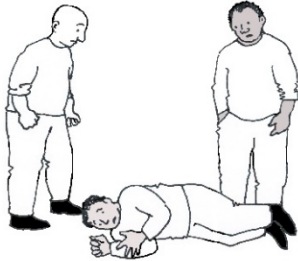
What should the YOI do?

We want the governor to make a plan. The plan should tell us how they will fix the problems at HMYOI Feltham A and make things better for young people.

What do we want to happen?



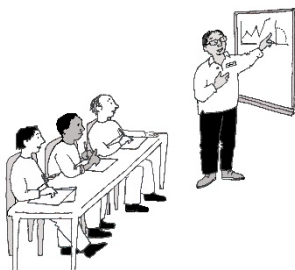
We want all young people to feel safe.

young people fighting.



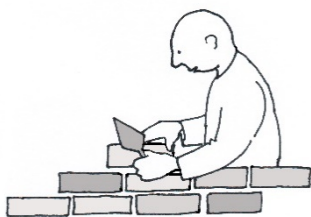
We want vulnerable young people to get

separated for less time.



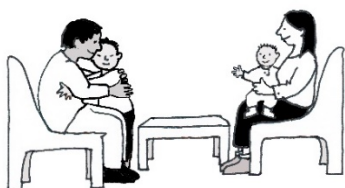
We want young people to have more

We want young people to have more chances to see family and friends.

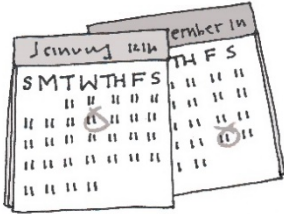


We want young people to get more support with their mental health. We want the YOI to do more to stop young people harming themselves.
