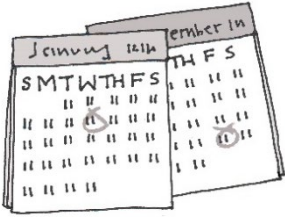
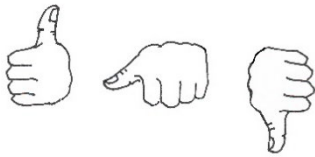




# Inspection of HMYOI Parc



Inspectors visited this establishment in March 2026.



We wanted to find out if things were better, the same or worse for children since we last visited in 2023.



Inspectors did this by:

- looking around the establishment
- asking children and staff to fill in a paper survey
- speaking to children
- speaking to staff and helpers
- reading documents.

# What did we find?



## **Safety: 4 out of 4**

- Most children said they felt safe on their first night.
- Children got the help they needed.
- Staff acted quickly to keep children safe.



## **Care: 4 out of 4**

- Staff treated children with care and respect.
- Cells were clean and in good condition.



## **Things to do: 4 out of 4**

- Most children got a good amount of time out of their cells.
- Children could learn skills and take part in activities.
- Separated children needed more time out of their cells.



## **Resettlement: 4 out of 4**

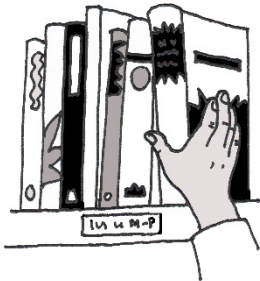
- Most children had education or a job sorted out for when they left Parc.
- Children got good support to get ready to leave Parc or move to an adult prison.
- Staff helped children see and speak to their families.

## What should the prison do?



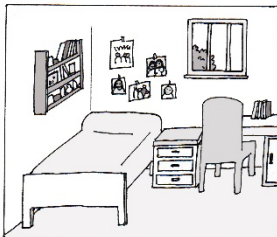
We want the governor to read the report we wrote about HMYOI Parc and make a plan.

You can find the report we wrote in the prison library.

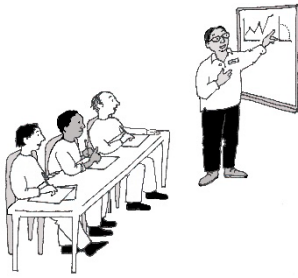
## What do we want to happen?

We want there to be more training courses so children can learn skills for jobs.

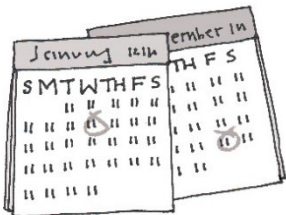


We want teachers to know how to help children with different needs.



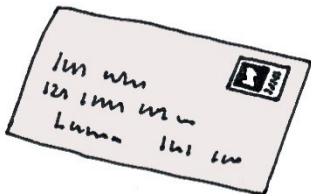
We want staff to know how to check children's calls and messages so that children and the public are kept safe.
