Thank you for your Freedom of Information request dated 21.11.2025.

Can I obtain this in one go via "freedom of information" request from you directly ? Eg; a report that encompasses all government agencies and departments and records in one go, rather than individually requesting via each agency or departments FOI division, from each that I'm aware of ?

If yes, thankyou kindly, what do you need from me ? ofcourse you will need the name and signed legal authority of the person which would be a start.

If no, can you provide me a consolidated list of such FOI branches nationally or internationally ? Specifically that shows all branches of governments and/or intergovernmental agencies that have FOI divisions (that access or use government records freely or inline with process that upon request of FOI in their powers do have such divisions that respond).

Can you share with me this total list please or make one to share ? as a matter of life saving importance, as to ensure every effort has been made to contact every single FOI division and to not miss any, nationally and or internationally.

I can confirm that we do not hold information in the scope of this request. HMCPSI are unable to provide a list of FOI branches nationally and internationally as per your request.
