The procedure will be reviewed and redesigned to ensure that risk assessments for hospital escorts fully take into account individual circumstances, including security assessments, input from healthcare and are based on the actual risk the prisoner presents at the time. 3	The Governor should ensure that a prisoner's family is notified as soon as possible when a prisoner becomes seriously ill.	Accepted	The prisoner's family will be notified as soon as possible when a prisoner becomes seriously ill. However, the prisoner's wishes must be taken into consideration if they have capacity to decide whether they wish the next of kin to be notified.
