1	The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that all staff undertaking risk assessments for prisoners taken to hospital understand the legal position on the use of restraints and that assessments fully take into account the health of a prisoner and are based on the actual risk the prisoner presents at the time.	Accepted	<p>In September 2016 work was undertaken to ensure that the information nursing staff provide towards the escort risk assessment is about the person's physical capabilities/mobility issues at the time. The decision to use restraints should be made by the manager authorising the escort paperwork. This has been communicated to the nursing team by the Modern Matron.</p> <p>It has been reiterated to all Senior Managers and Custodial Managers authorising escorts that they must make decisions that reflect the legal position on the use of restraints, and that assessments must fully take into account the health of a prisoner and be based on the actual risk the prisoner presents at the time</p> <p>A meeting was held to discuss these issues in September and the information has been cascaded electronically to all relevant managers.</p> <p>These issues are now discussed in the monthly Safe, Decent and Secure Committee meeting to ensure compliance.</p> <p>On receipt of this PPO recommendation the message has again been reinforced to all relevant managers.</p>	<p>Head of Res and Safety</p> <p>Completed</p>
