1	The Governors of HMP Wymott and HMP Preston should ensure that assessments fully take into account the health of a prisoner and are based on the actual risk the prisoner presents at the time.	Accepted	<p>Head of Healthcare at HMP Wymott and HMP Preston to remind all nursing staff of the need to share all appropriate health information that could have the potential to affect the escort risk assessment. This will also be communicated in the daily staff meetings and via the daily clinical handover on the health SystemOne.</p> <p>A Governors Order has been previously issued at HMP Wymott. The Order instructs staff to ensure that the new escort risk assessment forms are used with immediate effect when completing all escort risk assessments. The hospital escort risk assessment states: "A new risk assessment is required for every escort / appointment".
