1	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that healthcare staff are reminded of the importance of having a discussion and recording the outcome of conversations about resuscitation with prisoners with terminal conditions.	Accepted	The End of Life policy was revised in December 2016 and amended to include the importance of discussions around 'Do Not Attempt Resuscitation' (DNAR) and the need to document the discussions within the medical record. A palliative care team is in place with a lead GP and lead nurse. All patients with terminal illness will be reviewed by the team and DNAR discussions documented.	Head of Healthcare Completed
2	The Governor should ensure that a debrief is held promptly after the death of a prisoner and that all of the staff involved are offered effective support.	Accepted	A notice will be issued in May 2017 to duty governors to remind them that any staff escorting a prisoner who dies outside the establishment (i.e. on-route to hospital or whilst in hospital) must return to the establishment before going off shift. The duty governor will ensure that a debrief takes place on return to the establishment and that the staff involved are offered effective support, including Care Team and the Employee Assistance Programme. The Death In Custody contingency plan will be updated to include staff debrief and offer of support.	Head of Safer Custody May 2017
