1	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that prisoners with chronic illness are given the opportunity to discuss end of life wishes, including their wishes regarding resuscitation in the event of sudden collapse.	Accepted	<p>All patients with chronic illnesses are discussed at a weekly multidisciplinary team meeting attended by a GP and senior staff from mental health, substance misuse, primary care and psychosocial teams. Should either the patient or the multidisciplinary team feel it appropriate to discuss the patient's end of life wishes then this would be done in line with NHFT's Do not attempt cardio-pulmonary resuscitation policy (DNACPR) – CLP054 and the relevant documentation would be completed.</p> <p>Should a DNACPR be put in place whilst the patient is under secondary care then this would be reviewed upon their return to prison and the appropriate NHFT paperwork completed to ensure continuity of care. Following the patient's last admission to hospital in January 2017 where he declined treatment and his overall health then started to decline, the mental health team assessed the patient's capacity and at that point a conversation regarding resuscitation was being considered however the patient passed away prior to this taking place.</p>	<p>Head of Healthcare</p> <p>Reviewed June 2017</p> <p>Complete</p>
