1	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that prisoners with chronic and complex conditions have appropriate care plans and a recognised screening tool is used to monitor those who might be at risk of malnutrition.	Accepted	<p>Care plan training now forms part of the primary care model and will commence in October 2015 at the prison for all Primary Care nurses to use when working with prisoners with chronic and complex conditions. Weekly case meetings for primary care will be held (and minutes retained as evidence) to monitor the care plans of patients with complex health needs.</p> <p>Scores from the Malnutrition Universal screening (MUST) tool will form part of the risk assessment process to assist with nutrition management needs, and the score will form the basis of future treatment plans. This process will be monitored as part the care plan process for compliance on a quarterly basis.</p>	<p>Head of Healthcare</p> <p>Target date for completion: 31 Dec 2015</p>
