Accepted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There is a national programme for access to summary care records which HMP Wandsworth is included in. Upon implementation, healthcare staff will have access to external records which provide details of the GP surgery patients are registered with. This upgrade is planned for Q3 2017. Separately, the process for requesting clinical records was reviewed early in 2017, where amendments to the procedure were carried out. As part of these revisions, a clearer process for requesting records was set in place, with the addition of a regular check to ensure that all requested records were continuously chased up until received. 2	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that GPs review a prisoner's medication history to ensure continuity of healthcare in line with PSO 3050.	Accepted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recruitment for a medical summariser has been underway. The medical summariser will be recruited to process all GP records, assess medical records, summarise clinical information and medications and update S1. The medical summariser will work closely with GPs to flag any that require further care. This will ensure continuity in healthcare. Expected to be in post Q3 subject to clearances. A process is already in place to ensure that when prisoners return from hospital appointments; any discharge information is conveyed as appropriate to the GP for on-going management, medication in particular.
