1	The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that when staff raise medical concerns about prisoners with nursing staff, they should record this in the wing observation book and the prisoner's case notes. Nursing staff should act on concerns and make entries in a prisoner's SystemOne record. 2	The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that all staff undertaking risk assessments for prisoners taken to hospital or on a bed watch understand the legal position and that assessments fully take into account the health of a prisoner and are based on the actual risk the prisoner presents at the time.	Accepted	<p>A management check is to be undertaken within the first 24 hours of the bedwatch and thereafter in response to every significant change in circumstances and/or significant change in clinical condition-any significant changes must also be reflected and updated within the risk assessment to ensure that security measures remain appropriate and proportionate. To ensure that the clinical information is correct a discussion will need to take place with both the healthcare department and the clinical team who are treating the prisoner in the hospital. A decision on the appropriate level of restraints will then be made and will be evidenced on the risk assessment.
