1	<p>The Governor should ensure that prison staff manage prisoners at risk of suicide or self-harm in line with national guidelines. In particular:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The ACCT assessor, as set out in PSI 64/2011, should attend the initial multidisciplinary case review. Where this is not possible, the assessor must provide a handover to the case manager, and record that they have done so in the ACCT document. 	Accepted	<p>A Governor's notice to staff will be issued to remind all case managers that they must ensure that ACCT assessors attend all first case reviews and that, where this is not possible, a full verbal handover should be given in addition to the written assessment and evidenced in writing in the ACCT document.</p> <p>These requirements will be re-enforced at the next Safer Liverpool meeting, and a check will be added to the existing quality assurance process to ensure that this action is complied with.</p> <p>This will also be driven locally through delivery of the Suicide and Self-Harm (SASH) training.</p>	August 2017 Head of Safer Custody
