1	<p>The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that the mental health in-reach team are immediately informed when a prisoner is not complying with anti-psychotic and other mood altering medication. They should ensure that, where appropriate, discipline staff are made aware of non-compliance with medication so that a full risk assessment can take place.</p>	Accepted	<p>All medical staff were reminded during a verbal briefing during March 2017 that direct contact should be made with the prescribing team and Mental Health Team where a prisoner is not compliant with critical medication. This is covered in Section 1.12 of the Medication Administration policy and available via the Trust website, and was also circulated via email in April 2017.</p> <p>Where it is considered appropriate by the Mental Health team and the prescribing clinician, information relating to non-compliance will be shared with the discipline staff if there is evidence of an increased risk to self or others. This is outlined in the Protocol for Throughcare, which was verbally briefed to staff in March 2017, and an email outlining this information was circulated to these staff in April.</p> <p>This information now forms part of the induction for new healthcare staff.</p>	Head of Healthcare Completed.
