1	The Head of Healthcare should review the use of clinical assessment tools used within mental health services and ensure that all relevant staff are trained in the use and interpretation of the tools to ensure that prisoners are offered appropriate treatment from a suitably qualified member of staff.	Accepted	<p>Refresher training on the interpretation of assessment tool outcomes will be provided to all mental health nurses, by a senior nurse from the Yorkshire Region, by the end of June 2018. In addition, all mental health nurses receive clinical supervision once a month, to explore their clinical decision making and develop skills. The attendance and compliance with supervision is monitored using a service database.</p> <p>All prisoners are triage assessed using the Generalised Anxiety Disorder scale and Patient Health Questionnaire assessment tool. A self-harm template is also used if the need is identified. Following the daily triage clinic, each patient is now discussed at a mental health multi-disciplinary meeting. The triaging nurse is required to present cases and outcomes. This means clinical decisions are peer reviewed and scrutinised. During this meeting every defensible decision is recorded on the patient notes for future reference. If a decision is queried or causes concern, a follow up plan will be decided upon and actioned.</p>	Head of Healthcare June 2018
