1	The Governor should ensure that, at key points of the day, staff satisfy themselves of the safety and welfare of all prisoners and that there are no immediate issues that need attention.	Accepted	<p>During the core day prisoners are visibly checked for their safety and welfare at all roll checks at the following times; 0600, 1230, 1930, and 2200. When prisoners are unlocked at 0745 on weekdays and 0845 at weekends they are not visibly checked, the landing gates are opened and prisoners make their way out for association, Education, Programmes or Employment. Staff will be reminded of the above by way of a Notice to Staff in November 2018.</p> <p>There is currently a planned refurbishment of A and B wing scheduled for 2019, once the plans have been completed and a greater knowledge of the layout is clear, i.e. either cellular accommodation or simply an upgrade of the dormitory accommodation already in place, it will then be possible to complete a further review of how and when physical checks can be carried out.
