1	<p>The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure there is an effective drug strategy to reduce the trading of prescribed medication, which includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A greater emphasis on the risks from prescribed medication, and action to address the diversion of medication.</li> <li>• Ensuring all staff understand the importance of the intelligence system for the effective management of risk and are properly trained to identify and submit intelligence.</li> </ul>	Accepted	<p>The Supply and Reduction strategy will be reviewed and will include commitment from the establishment and key partners in the restriction of supply and demand of illicit substances with the aim of delivering a consistent approach to illicit use with constructive regimes, opportunities to address drug and alcohol misuse and incentives to change behaviour.</p> <p>The strategy will also focus on the management of those who trade medication through the inclusion of a diversion which will outline how the establishment will manage any prisoner on prescribed medication that could, if misused or abused, hold a risk of harm. These individuals will be reviewed and risk assessed by healthcare partners on a regular basis. Consideration will include;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Risk to the patient holding the medication</li> <li>• Risk of harm through misuse/abuse of medication.</li> <li>• Historic medical information around history of abuse.</li> <li>• Time on medication and current dosage.</li> </ul> <p>After consideration of relevant risk of harm, a decision will be made on continuation of medication, withdrawal of medication or GP appointment for alternative treatment options.</p> <p>Training is included in the initial induction to the prison, however further training will now be facilitated for all partner agencies around the use of the prison intelligence system and their responsibility within it to report all intelligence.</p> <p>Further to this a Notice to Staff will be issued in regards to the management of intelligence, and assurance checks will be included to</p>	<p>Deputy Governor June 2018</p> <p>Head of Security February 2018</p> <p>Head of Security March 2018</p>
