1	The head of healthcare at HMP Manchester should ensure that staff employ an appropriate weight management tool such as MUST promptly to identify and manage prisoners who are at risk of weight loss or malnutrition.	Accepted	All prisoners identified as having a weight problem must be assessed using the MUST (Malnutrition Universal Screening Tool). This includes prisoners who are under weight. Healthcare at HMP Manchester also assess overweight prisoners and arrange for them to see a dietician. Staff have been reminded of the requirement to complete the tool and that the assessment must be done as soon as possible. The reminder to staff was carried out in staff meetings and via email in November 2017 and more recently in March 2018.	Completed Head of Healthcare D Press
2	The head of healthcare at Manchester should ensure that staff are aware of the risk of pressure sores for prisoners with limited mobility, and that they use an appropriate monitoring tool as early as possible.	Accepted	All prisoners who are on the inpatient unit have a Waterlow pressure assessment done. This is the tool used at HMP Manchester. Staff have been reminded via email and staff meeting to use the Waterlow on any prisoner who has any mobility issues.	Completed Head of Healthcare D Press
