2	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that prisoners with long-term conditions are managed and reviewed in line with guidance.	Accepted	<p>Continuing actions means that Long Term Conditions (LTC) processes in particular with regards to dementia patients are continuously reviewed, the last one being completed in October 2018. Patients are identified on reception/second screening as having a LTC. A pre-set care plan which observes the respective NICE (National Institute for Health and Care Excellence) Guidance for that particular LTC is opened and followed for LTCs and the screening nurse informs Admin by way of audited tasks on SystmOne to allocate to nurse clinic.</p> <p>When patients are diagnosed with an LTC an icon on SystmOne becomes present on the patient page, highlighting this diagnosis.</p> <p>National templates on SystmOne are followed and completed for each patient contact in this clinic.
