1	The Governor should ensure that all staff undertaking and reviewing risk assessments for prisoners taken to and admitted to hospital understand the legal position, that assessments fully take into account a prisoner's health and are based on the actual risk he presents at the time.	Accepted	<p>Staff responsible for undertaking and reviewing risk assessments for prisoners taken and admitted to hospital have been written to, reminding them of their legal obligation. This was done in November 2018</p> <p>A review of the risk assessment template has been completed November 2018 to include offence, age, health/medical concerns, risk to others and self and risk of escape at the time of the risk assessment being completed. Recent custodial behaviour is also considered.</p> <p>When a prisoner is admitted to hospital, a daily review of the risk assessment will be completed by a manager. Any medical changes would trigger a full risk assessment review conducted by the duty governor</p> <p>The senior management team will monitor risk assessments via the senior managers meeting from December 2018.</p>	Complete Governor
2	The Governor should ensure that a family liaison officer is appointed to engage with the next of kin when a prisoner becomes seriously ill.	Accepted	A Family Liaison rota has been introduced in December 2018 and all Duty Managers have been advised that a FLO should be appointed and make contact with the next of kin when a prisoner becomes seriously ill. The Head of Safety will ensure contact has been made.	Complete Governor
