2	The Governor should ensure that all staff undertaking risk assessments for prisoners taken to hospital understand the legal position, and that assessments fully take into account the health of a prisoner and are based on the actual risk the prisoner presents at the time.	Accepted	All Custodial Managers are fully aware of the requirements regarding restraints in respects of prisoners leaving the establishment during medical emergencies.
