The Head of Healthcare should ensure that prison GPs and other healthcare staff understand the purpose and outcomes of healthcare segregation visits and communicate with prisoners appropriately to ensure their welfare and wellbeing.	Accepted	<p>The Head of Healthcare has provided the nursing and healthcare teams with a copy of Dartmoor's local segregation policy to ensure that they are familiar with the policy, and to remind them of the requirement to satisfy themselves of the wellbeing of prisoners located in the segregation unit, and record their interactions with them to improve the quality of local documentation.</p> <p>Healthcare staff no longer use the auto consultation tool on SystmOne to record their visits to prisoners in the segregation unit; staff are now required to make a narrative entry within the prisoner's patient record to ensure they sufficiently document their visit and assessment of the patient at that time.</p> <p>Record keeping workshops have been attended by Healthcare staff and they will continue to be delivered, to maintain good standards and promote discussion regarding the quality of recorded information.</p> <p>An audit of Healthcare segregation rounds will be recommended to take place in six months to assess quality and compliance.</p>	<p>Head of Healthcare Completed</p> <p>Completed</p> <p>Completed and continuing.</p> <p>April 2017</p>
