Accepted	<p>The Governor will issue a staff information notice (SIN) to remind all staff that they must manage prisoners at risk of suicide and self-harm in line with national guidelines including the need for staff to consider all known risk factors and triggers when determining their risk of suicide and self-harm. The Governor will ensure that segregation staff are prioritised for training related to suicide and self-harm.</p> <p>The Head of Healthcare will remind all healthcare staff of the risk factors for suicide and self-harm and ensure that these are included in assessing the wellbeing of a prisoner during the initial Segregation Health Screen. 2	<p>The Governor should ensure that restrictive measures taken to address security threats are considered and proportionate and that their potential impact on the welfare of prisoners is taken into account.</p>	Accepted	<p>Actions taken in response to security threats must balance the needs of the prisoner with the security of the establishment and risks to staff and other prisoners. Decisions are based on all the information available at the time. This will be communicated through the Service Level User group meeting which is held monthly. This will also be communicated as part of the initial induction for Healthcare staff.
