Accepted	The refresh of the Suicide and Self-Harm Reduction Project included the recruitment of a dedicated full-time lead in March 2017 to oversee the Early Days work stream activity. This role will include identification and evaluation of good practice across the estate and sharing where relevant. The work at HMP Exeter will be considered as part of this work stream activity. 2	The Governor should remind all staff of the roll check procedures and expectations. There should also be a review of the current process to ensure that Officer Corner's actions were an isolated incident.	Accepted	All staff will be reminded verbally of the local instructions regarding roll checks as set out in the Local Security Strategy. A Governor's Order will also be issued to remind staff of this requirement. In addition, this matter will be addressed at the prison's safer custody meeting which will review learning from PPO reports, and be attended by staff from all departments.
