1	The Head of Healthcare should review the safeguarding and complex care monitoring system to ensure that prisoners with complex care needs are monitored regularly so that any deterioration in their condition is identified promptly and managed effectively.	Accepted	Dementia patients have been added to the weekly complex case meeting and register. This allows for the needs of patients to be discussed and reviewed with actions taking place as appropriate. This was introduced in March 2019.	Complete Healthcare
2	The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that where it is clear that a prisoner's care needs are going to increase in future, advance planning for a move to a more suitable location should begin in good time.	Accepted	Prison and healthcare staff will carry out early planning for a prisoner's move an appropriate location upon notification that a move of establishment may be required. The process will be expedited through escalation by healthcare to the regional NHSE Commissioner to ensure that a suitable location is secured where it appears there are difficulties in identifying and securing a suitable location.
