2	The Governor should ensure that when a prisoner is taken to hospital seriously ill, their next of kin is informed without delay.	Accepted	An email was sent to all Duty Governors, Senior Management Team and Custodial Managers to remind them of the importance of contacting the next of kin when a prisoner has been taken to hospital seriously ill. A reminder of this has also been published in the staff bulletin and contingency plans are being updated to include the requirement to contact next of kin.	July 2019 Governor
