1	The Director should ensure that the key drug issues at Dovegate are identified and that the prison's local drugs strategy is revised by September 2019 to address these key issues.	Accepted	The revised Drug Strategy was ratified at the end of August 2019 and has now been communicated to all staff as a live document. The strategy focusses on restricting supply, reducing demand and building recovery. Monthly Drug Strategy meetings are held with a full multi-disciplinary attendance. This meeting is chaired by the Head of Rehabilitative services.	Complete Rehabilitative services Security
2	The Director should ensure that prisoners suspected of using PS, or other illicit Substances, are managed in line with the local drug strategy.	Accepted	In line with the revised Drug Strategy, there are clear process maps for the safe management of residents that are suspected of using PS, or other illicit items. The referral process to the relevant support is clearly indicated. This information was communicated to all staff in August 2019.	Complete Rehabilitative services
3	The Director and Head of Healthcare should ensure that healthcare staff are Involved in ACCT reviews whenever possible.	Accepted	The Safer Custody Department have taken ownership of the management of all ACCT within HMP Dovegate (since April 2019). Healthcare staff are invited to all ACCT reviews. Mental health nurses attend the majority of initial reviews and also any reviews with residents working under the mental health team.	Complete Safer Custody
