1	The Head of Healthcare should ensure the nutritional needs of patients are assessed and that NICE guidance is followed to ensure that appropriate management and care planning is in place.	Accepted	If any issues or concerns are raised to healthcare regarding nutritional intake then healthcare staff follow NICE guidelines and complete a Malnutrition Universal Screening Tool (MUST score) and commence a fluid input and output balance chart to monitor the patient. This is a 5 step screening tool to identify adults who are malnourished or at risk of malnutrition. It also includes guidelines that can be issued to develop care plans. This is monitored by the carers on the wing. If a special diet is required then a form is completed and sent to the kitchen in order for them to prepare a special diet. Healthcare staff monitor patients weight in a nurse clinic and can refer appropriately to the external hospital if required.	Complete  Head of Healthcare
