2	The Head of Healthcare should ensure staff are familiar with, and where appropriate use, the National Early Warning Score tool.	Accepted	NEWS is located on the SystmOne tree for all clinical staff to access. Staff also have to complete mandatory e-learning on NEWS, which is currently up to date. Any prisoners of concern are also discussed at the Lunchtime Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) brief. The revised Daily Handover Meeting form includes a Section for notes to be recorded for prisoners of concern.	Complete Head of Healthcare
3	The Head of Healthcare should ensure all staff are aware of prisoners' resuscitation wishes.	Accepted	The MDT Lunchtime briefings and a list of Do Not Attempt Resuscitation (DNAR) is kept in the Nurses room on Woodlands. All clinical staff are also training up to The Resuscitation Council UK Immediate Life Support level and this is updated yearly as per Trust guidelines. We also keep wing officers informed of a prisoner's DNAR status. The revised Daily Handover Meeting form includes a Section for recording DNAR status.	Complete Head of Healthcare
