2	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that Advance Care Planning must be considered for those prisoners who have a DNACPR in place so that their wishes are respected, such as their preferred place of death.	Accepted	The Head of Healthcare and clinical matron have completed training on when to consider Advanced Care Planning and are completing a mortality review of potential cases for discussions to occur with the prisoners identified.
