Accepted	The Head of Healthcare has reminded all members of the Dying Well in Custody panel at HMP Wakefield that all advanced care plans are discussed with the patient by the Respiratory consultant and Oncologist who are also members of the Gold Standard Framework meetings delivered on site. Due to a recent change in the clinical management team the Head of Healthcare will chair these meetings and create a checklist for standard actions which will include patient engagement. 2	The Governor and Head of Healthcare at HMP Wakefield should ensure that applications for compassionate release are progressed in a timely manner and submitted as promptly as possible.	Accepted	Early release applications are discussed as part of the Gold Standard Framework (GSF) routinely as standard practice. This allows for consideration of each case and continuous review throughout the Dying Well in Custody process.  The Safety Intervention Meetings will be recommenced (in reduced capacity) from September 2020, where all prisoners subject to the GSF will be reviewed at the meetings.
