Accepted	<p>The Primary Care Coordinator is to commence in-house training in NEWS 2 escalation and Sepsis identification with the healthcare team, planned for August 2020.</p> <p>We have 18 substantive staff members and we use 3 agency workers that only work at Low Newton. 15 substantive staff members have completed their NEWS 2 training however, 2 staff members are on long term sick so we are only waiting for one certificate. We have had no feedback from the agency at present so this is ongoing at present as they do not complete Spectrum’s mandatory training.</p> <p>Additionally, the Head of Healthcare has completed a NEWS2 training audit to look at compliance, which was completed on 30 July 2020.
