1	The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that prisoners addicted to drugs are appropriately monitored and managed according to the relevant tools and guidelines.	Accepted	The SMS pathway was reviewed and launched in Nov 2018 within a dedicated SMS team and is now utilised for first night prescribing against best practice guidelines to ensure prisoners are appropriately monitored and managed on arrival. The SMS team also have a dedicated GP, who reviews all receptions the following morning and all SMS patients are monitored and managed through COWS, CIWA, fifth day reviews in collaboration with CGL and thirteen week reviews. 2	The Governor should ensure that the key drug issues at Liverpool are identified and that the prison's local drugs strategy is revised by November 2019 to ensure that these key issues are being addressed.	Accepted	The prisons drug strategy was reviewed and updated in April 2019 in line with the new national guidance and to ensure the key issues have been identified and addressed. A supply/demand reduction action plan has been introduced which is monitored through the monthly Drug Strategy meeting. The Drug Strategy meeting is now embedded with good attendance from key functions. A weekly Know Our Prisoners meeting is also held, which is attended by key stakeholders and addresses men suspected of distributing drugs and men who are vulnerable due to drug use.
