1	<p>The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that all staff undertaking risk assessments for prisoners taken to hospital understand the legal position on the use of restraints and that assessments fully take into account the health of a prisoner and are based on the actual risk the prisoner presents at the time.</p>	Accepted	<p>An Operational Order covering paragraph 6.8 of the National Security Framework will be published for all members of staff. This will provide the necessary guidance on taking into account the prisoner's health and all other factors to reach a sound decision on the need for the use of restraints</p> <p>In addition to this, HMP Long Lartin has selected a number of Custodial Managers to attend a training package on Defensible Decision Making. This occurred in October 2019. This training will be cascaded to operational staff on 11 December 2019 as part of an establishment training event.</p>	<p>November 2019</p> <p>Head of Security/ Head of Healthcare</p> <p>December 2019</p> <p>Head of Safer Custody</p>
2	<p>The Governor should revise the prison's escort risk assessment form to ensure that it requires:</p> <p>Healthcare staff to say whether the prisoner's current state of health has an impact on his mobility; and</p> <p>Prison staff to show that they have taken this information into account in assessing the prisoner's current level of risk, and should send the Ombudsman a copy of the revised form.</p>	Accepted	<p>The current prison's escort risk assessment form will be reviewed and revised to ensure that it is fit for purpose reflecting the current guidance in the National Security Framework and the legal judgement.</p> <p>Ensuring that the form requires healthcare staff to say whether the prisoner's current state of health has an impact on his mobility. Prison staff will also document the assessment to show the medical information has been taken into account when assessing the prisoner's current level of risk posed.</p> <p>A revised copy of the Prison Escort Risk Assessment will be forwarded to the Ombudsman.</p>	<p>November 2019</p> <p>Head of Security/ Head of Healthcare</p>
