1	The Governor should ensure that all staff undertaking risk assessments for prisoners taken to hospital understand the legal position on the use of restraints and that assessments fully take into account the health of a prisoner and are based on the actual risk the prisoner presents at the time.	Accepted	<p>The following actions will be implemented :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Publish advice to all Senior Management Team (SMT) members highlighting the need for consideration of the actual risk the prisoner presents at the time of the escort;</li> <li>2. Presentation to all SMT members of the need for this consideration and to highlight sections of the risk assessment to consider when making a decision on restraints;</li> <li>3. Change to the escort risk assessment to add a section to the Authorising Governor’s Decision page to acknowledge due consideration of the need for restraints and the actual risk posed as that time to include the health/mobility of the prisoner; and</li> <li>4. Assurance checks by Head of Security are carried out to ensure that Authorising Governors have shown due consideration of this recommendation.
