Training has and is being provided for all staff who are responsible for record keeping, this commenced in October 2017 and will continue until all staff have completed the training. 2	The Head of Healthcare should ensure that all prisoners with serious or long term health conditions have detailed care plans in place in accordance with National Institute for Clinical Excellence guidance.	Accepted	There is now a Community Matron in post who is reviewing all prisoners with long term conditions. The Community Matron is able to obtain the names all prisoners with serious and long term conditions from QOF (Quality Outcomes Framework) and HJIP (Health and Justice Indicators of Performance). She has commenced reviewing all these prisoners and creating and/or updating care plans. Where necessary she will refer the prisoner for review by the doctor, or/and refer on to outside agencies where necessary.	Complete Head of Healthcare
3	The Governor should ensure that the control room call an ambulance immediately when a medical emergency code is received.	Accepted	In line with the recommendations a notice to staff has been issued on the 14/11/2017 regarding Emergency Response Codes; this is a re-issue of NTS 127/16. All staff undergoing the new Suicide and Self-Harm (SASH) training are made aware of the (Emergency Response Information Criteria (ERIC) response codes. They are given an information card with details of what the different codes represent. This training will be given to all staff including operational and non-operational, currently the prison aims to provide 3 sessions per week and 108 staff have completed modules in SASH so far.
